## *Estate Bottled Wines*

Produced and bottled from grapes grown in our vineyards

**2010 Chardonnay (dry) .....\$16**

Originally from the Burgundy region of France. A full-bodied, light-colored wine with a soft nose and crisp fruit flavors.

**2010 Pinot Gris (dry) .....\$16**

Called Pinot Grigio in Italy. A full-bodied wine with a fruity and flowery taste and slight mineral aroma.

**2010 Muscat Ottonel (med dry) .....\$16**

Made from the coolest growing and palest of Muscat grapes. Has a distinctive Muscat flavor and aroma (a characteristic mix of tropical fruits).

**2010 Riesling (med sweet) .....\$15**

Grown in Germany since the 14<sup>th</sup> century. A wine with complexly floral flavors. Finished sweet to balance its inherent high acidity.

**2010 Gewürztraminer (med sweet) ..\$15**

Originally from Germany. This “spicy traminer” makes an exceptionally light bodied wine endowed with powerful flavors and aromas.

**2010 Traminette (med dry) .....\$14**

A relatively new grape created by crossing Gewürztraminer with a fairly obscure French Hybrid. This wine has a rich amber color and powerful flavors and aromas.

**2010 Cabernet Franc (dry) .....\$16**

Lighter and fruitier than its Cabernet Sauvignon relative. This wine has cherry and blackberry flavor and a smooth finish.

**2010 Pinot Noir (dry) .....\$18**

A popular Burgundy grape. Its thin, lightly pigmented skin yields a wine with a pale color and light body. It has a cherry tone and light tannin.

**2010 Dornfelder (med dry) .....\$15**

The most widely-grown of German grapes. Makes an inky purple, velvety-textured, medium bodied wine with hints of blackberry and boysenberry.

**2010 Lemberger (dry) .....\$15**

Grown in Europe under many names. This German variety makes an easy to drink wine that is pale in color and lacking pronounced tannins.

**2010 Chambourcin (dry) .....\$14**

Perhaps one of the most popular French hybrids that makes a deep-colored, medium bodied wine with full aromatic flavor and light tannins.

**Cabernet Sauvignon (dry) .....\$15**

Produced in our winery from American grapes because it requires a long, hot growing season to perform best. This full bodied red wine has strong tannins and a dry finish.

An American grape principally used in the production of grape juice. This white wine is crisp and sweet.

A light bodied American red wine characterized by a pronounced foxy flavor and aroma.

An American wine with a pink color and light but distinctive labrusca flavor.
